Notice of works to Parnell's Hill Wood Culvert

A recent routine inspection the Parnell's Hill Wood Culvert recorded extensive undermining beneath the structure. A further structural inspection undertaken by the Structures Area Technician and Principal Engineer concluded emergency works needed to be undertaken as soon as possible to prevent further degradation of the structure.

The culvert is located 0.3 miles north of East Portholland and supports the C0023 road. The road is one of the two access routes to the village and runs north to south from Great Polgrain Farm to the East Portholland. The restricted road width requires the closure of the road for the duration of the works. A diversion route to the west via West Portholland will be put in place to allow access to East Portholland.


We understand the inconvenience and disruption will be caused by the closure of the road, however it is essential the works are completed to ensure the stability of the highway. CORMAC are working to keep disruption to a minimum and hope residents understand the need to undertake this work.

CORMAC are planning to commence the works on 27th June 2022 once emergency consents are agreed. Depending on the extent of the damage to the structure we are anticipating the works will be completed over a 2 – 3 week period. If there is a delay in receiving consent the start date will need be delayed however we will inform you if there is any change to this date.
